Entry to the ABSD Awards Level 4 (UK) Certificate is 'open' to interested learners over the age of 18 and no prior qualifications or experience are required.

Entry to the ABSD Awards Level 5 (UK) Diploma is open to holders of the ABSD Awards Level 4 (UK) Certificate or equivalent. Prior learning or experience (RPL) means that it may also be possible to join without an ABSD Awards Level 4 (UK) qualification for holders of other post-second level qualification(s) or experience or both. Each application will be considered on a case-by-case basis.

Entry to the ABSD Awards Level 6 (UK) Advanced Diploma is open to holders of the ABSD Awards Level 5 (UK) Diploma or equivalent. RPL may also apply on a case by case basis.

Entry to the Masters Degree is open to holders of the ABSD Awards Level (6) Advanced Diploma.

ENGLISH Proficiency at IELTS Level 6.5 is required for admission to all courses.
