The Erasmus+ programme is designed to foster a skilled and dynamic work force within the European Union. It allows students in vocational education and training to undertake temporary transnational training / work placements in Europe over a 3-week period, gaining an understanding of different cultures, languages and work practices.

This enables students to improve and develop their individual personal, social and professional skills. It allows organisations to work with European partners, in order to exchange practices and increase expertise of students whilst abroad.

The demand for Erasmus+ projects has increased in Moate Business College over the last few years with students benefiting from placements in Romania, Spain and Lithuania.
